Supply List

12 yards of fabric: I love to work with silk noil, which makes beautiful quilts and is easy to sew. If you prefer cotton, try to choose a quality cotton that you know dyes well, either through experience, or by asking other dyers you know. Your success in this workshop will rely on the fabric you choose.

PREWASH ALL FABRIC - EVEN IF IT IS PFD. IT DOES MAKE A DIFFERENCE. Use soda ash or if you are unfamiliar with that chemical use a detergent without perfumes and additives, like All Free and Clear.

It will save a great deal of time to divide your fabric into fat quarters in advance. Tearing it is fine, and faster.

MARK the corner of each fat quarter with an indelible black marker, using your full initials. OR you can sew a Tyvek tag with your initials onto the corner of each piece, but make sure it is sewn down completely and not hanging off the fabric.

Dust mask

Old towel for clean up

Pencil or pen

Small brass safety pins (at least 48)
