## Materials list

Paint Golden Fluid Acrylics or Liquitex soft body or any other fluid acrylics that you like to use, in the colors you want to use. Pick several color schemes from these: monochromatic, achromatic, complimentary, split complimentary, analogous, analogous plus a compliment, triadic, etc. plus black and white. (from experience the students were much happier with the Golden Fluid Acrylics) 4 or 8 oz bottles

Mediums:	Batting.
Golden Additive: Acrylic Flow Release small bottle, and an empty squeeze bottle to mix flow release with water GAC 100 for treating the canvases (32oz for 3 or 5 day class)	Fabric to assimilate onto the surface of canvas. I like to use graphic checks and grids and dots but anything that you would like to put on the surface and then paint over and stitch into (fat quarters or less)
Yogurt containers or some such container for mixing	xacto knife,
with color and water.	18 x 24" mat, rotary cutter, 18" ruler,
